## *Part II: Will of God Made Simple*

### **SCRIPTURE**

Colossians 1:9-14

### **QUESTIONS**

1. What are some of the ways you have heard of that people have tried to determine God's will about a particular issue? What are the faults in these methods?
2. Share a time in your life when you have wrestled with finding God's will in your life.
3. Respond to this statement - "God's will is not so much about the decisions we make as it is about the life we live."
4. What are good deeds that bear fruit? (verse 10, Ephesians 2:10, 1 Peter 2:11-12, Mathew 5:16)
5. Explain the difference between knowing about God and knowing God? (verse 10)
6. How does the passage Romans 12:1-2 help us in seeking God's will?
7. "If I am in God's will everything in life should go smooth." (verse 11) Do you agree or disagree with this statement and why?
8. Many people say, "Don't pray for patience." Why do you think they say this, and how does this square with what scripture teaches?
9. Why do you think God wants us to be thankful? What does thankfulness produce? What does Paul express thankfulness for? What stands out the most to you? (verses 12-14 and 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18)
10. Which area do you feel God is directing you to focus on? (bearing fruit, knowing Him better, toughening up, being thankful).
