



Part 1 :: What Not to Wear Colossians 3:1-11

- » How do you shop for clothes and what things are most important when doing so? (Name brands, bargains and sales, quality, etc.)
- » We get all too used to “earthly nature clothing.” Which aspect of your old nature feels like a comfortable old T-shirt to you now? Why is it difficult to remove?
- » How does our “earthly nature clothing” effect our witness and our relationships with others?
- » Discuss the importance and implications of verse 2 in dealing with our “earthly nature.” (How do we accomplish this “setting our mind on...”?)
- » What does it mean to be “hidden in Christ” (verses 3-4) and how does that help me in my striving to live as Christ’s follower?
- » How could verses 3 and 4 change our perspective on our day-to-day living and how we “clothe ourselves”? (What difference would it make if I viewed my life through an eternal perspective)
- » What are some of the ways that we can “put to death” the things that belong to our earthly nature? (verses 5-10) How do we rid ourselves of these “clothes”?
- » How does God help us in this process?
- » Describe the “new self” that we are to put on, and some of the things that will encourage the renewal that God will bring about?
- » What will I do this week in response to God’s word?



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
